

WHAT TO DO ON YOUR DAY IN COURT

When you arrive at Court

- Check the court list for your name and what court you are in.
- Have you seen a lawyer?
 - If not - go to the legal aid office and speak to a duty lawyer about your case.

In court

- Turn off your phone.
- Take off your hat and sunnies.
- When the Magistrate comes in - stand up and do a small bow.
- Stand up when the Magistrate wants to talk to you.
- Keep quiet while you wait for your case - it may take a while!

After your case is heard

- If the Magistrate asks you to sign a bond or a probation order, make sure you wait in Court to sign the agreement.
- When you leave - if the Magistrate is still sitting, do a small bow just before you leave the Courtroom.
